Amendment in Clause 14(g) and 15 – regarding Interview & Final Merit List

14 (g). Interview: Posts at Sl. No. 3, 4, 5 & 6: - As per merit in the Mains examination candidates will be called for interview. Candidates who qualify for interview will be assessed in the interview and will be awarded marks out of 20. The candidates who qualify the (CBT) (written test) will be shortlisted in the ratio of 1:5 for interview based on the theory merit. The date (s) and time of interview for shortlisted candidates would be displayed on the institute's Website. 15. Final Merit List: - - For Posts Sl. No. 3, 4, 5 & 6 will be prepared based on aggregate marks obtained in mains exam and interview. - For all other posts: The final merit list will be prepared based on the marks obtained in mains exam only for all categories (i.e. UR, OBC, SC, ST, EWS, PwBD etc.) separately and rank will be awarded to all qualified applicants. While preparing the merit list for the UR, all applicants (including those from the reserved categories) will be taken into consideration based on merit, but while preparing the merit list for a reserved category, only applicants of that category will be taken into consideration. The same method will be applicable in all reserved categories.	14 (g). Interview: Posts at Sl. Preferential Qualifications: - 3 years of work experience in an emergency/casualty department/unit of a government/semi-government or corporate hospital of at least 100 beds.
Lady Medical Officer	MBBS degree in a university recognized by the Medical Council of India or a Graduate Medical Degree recognized by the National Medical Commission Act, 2019. The candidate will be required to be registered with the UP State Medical Council or MCI/NMC. Only applications from female candidates will be accepted for the post of Lady Medical Officer. Preferential Qualifications: - 3 years of work experience in an emergency/casualty department/unit of a government/semi-government or corporate hospital of at least 100 beds..
Casualty Medical Officer	MBBS degree in a university recognized by the Medical Council of India or a Graduate Medical Degree recognized by the National Medical Commission Act, 2019. The candidate will be required to be registered with the UP State Medical Council or MCI/NMC. Preferential Qualifications: - 3 years of work experience in an emergency/casualty department/unit of a government/semi-government or corporate hospital of at least 100 beds.
