

**CME CUM SENSITIZATIONPROGRAM ON
“PHARMACOVIGILANCE ANDRATIONAL THERAPEUTICS”**

A CME cum Sensitization Program on “Pharmacovigilance and Rational Therapeutics” was conducted on 15 November 2019, with the aim to bring in safe and rational use of Drugs for the benefit of patients. It was organised by the Department of Pharmacology in collaboration with NCC, PvPI, IPC, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Govt of India.

On this occasion “PHARMACOALERT”, a monthly news letter to be published by the Department of Pharmacology, giving information about drug safety alert, New Drug marketed, Drug-drug interactions and list of banned drugs, was unveiled by the Chief guest, Director, Dr. RMLIMS, Dr. AK Tripathi in presence of the dignitaries and delegates.

The guest speaker Dr. RK Dixit, Professor, Department of Pharmacology, KGMU, Lucknow, delivered a guest lecture entitled on “Role of Pharmacovigilance in Rational Pharmacotherapy - A Key for Best Therapeutic Outcomes.”
