Part A Theory Examination :-

Part B Practical assessment :

Short listed candidates as per merit after Part-A Theory examination shall be notified to appear for Part B- Departmental Practical assessment.

Part 'B' examination time & Date – 3:00 PM onwards; 22nd September, 2020

Part 'B' examination venue : Seminar Room, 7th floor, Department of Pathology ,
OPD Building, Superspeciality Block, Dr. RMLIMS Lucknow.

1. On the day of examination the candidate must **bring their photo ID along with two color photographs**. The color photograph should be the same as sent with the application form.
2. No students will be allowed to enter the examination hall 15 minutes after the commencement of the examination. Students will be allowed to leave the examination hall only at the end of the examination when instructed by the Invigilator.
3. Thermal screening will be done at entrance point.
4. **Students have to sanitize their hands before and after entering/exiting exam hall & signing the attendance sheet.**
5. It is mandatory for every student to carry their identity card and admit card without which entry will not be permitted.
6. Students shall sign the attendance sheet when directed to do so by the invigilator(s).
7. **Mobile phones, smart digital watches, wallet etc. are strictly prohibited** inside exam venue. Do not carry any such thing to exam hall.
8. Students are advised not to carry bags, books, notebooks or any other personal belongings to the examination hall premises. Safety/security of any personal belongings kept outside the examination hall/premises shall not be the responsibility of the examination section.
9. Students must bring their own drinking water in transparent water bottles.
10. Students must wear a **suitable face mask as recommended by Government** and have to **keepwearing the mask on at all times during the examination.**
11. **Avoid crowding** at entry and exit points. Stand in queue outside the exam hall maintaining social distancing of atleast 2 meters.
12. Seating plan has been made so as to ensure social distancing.
13. If using toilets, wash hands properly before exiting the toilet.
14. After the exam is over **no gathering/crowding or group discussion is allowed in premises.**
