II. Dissection Instruments

Dissection kit should include:

- 2. Forceps (2): toothed, pointed & non-toothed (medium size)
- 3. Scissors (2): blunt & sharp (small)
- 4. Mounted needle
- 5. Brush
- 6. Inch tape

III. Stationery

Students should have the following stationery with them:

Registers: 9 Histology (H & E pencils) Color pencils (Faber Castell)

IV. Instructions to Students:

- 1. Punctuality and discipline should be maintained by the students at all times.
- 2. Students should be dressed in formals (boys: collared shirt and dark colored trousers with formal shoes; girls: suit salwar with dupatta and shoes)
- 3. T-shirts, jeans, leggings, sleeve-less dresses, sport shoes are not allowed for both boys and girls.
- 4. Students are advised to tie their loose hair back.
- 5. Students are expected to wear a white long sleeved, knee length apron.
- 6. Students should have their own dissection kit and gloves.
- 7. Gloves should be thrown into the trash can after use and should not be reused.
- 8. Students should bring their gross anatomy and histology manuals daily to respective labs.
- Each student must bring along the following essential items for personal protection:

All students have to be in college uniform mandatorily for college functions/ college day eas under:
